Include Pages 1 and 2 of BHA Membership Form for 2020, filled out in full
Carefully read over Code of Conduct, Constitution, Bylaws and Rules. (Available on our website www.burnabyhorsemensassociation.com under "About" tab)
Sign the Membership Application (page 1), sign the Code of Conduct (page 2), initial (if agreed) points concerning receipt of emails, sharing of personal information and volunteering.
Include a photocopy of 2020 HCBC membership.
Include signed ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY (age appropriate) and Safety Equipment Release (if applicable)
Include a photocopy of BCID or BCDL confirming Burnaby residency (for first time Burnaby residents only)
Include a completed Stall Sublease Application form (only if you wish to be placed on the Stall Waitlist)
Include a cheque or money order made payable to BHA for the correct membership fee.
Do not submit partial applications. Only fully completed application packages will be presented/accepted for consideration. <i>This checklist page DOES NOT need to be submitted</i> .
